- A reward system with currency encourages students to think strategically to buy activities and games

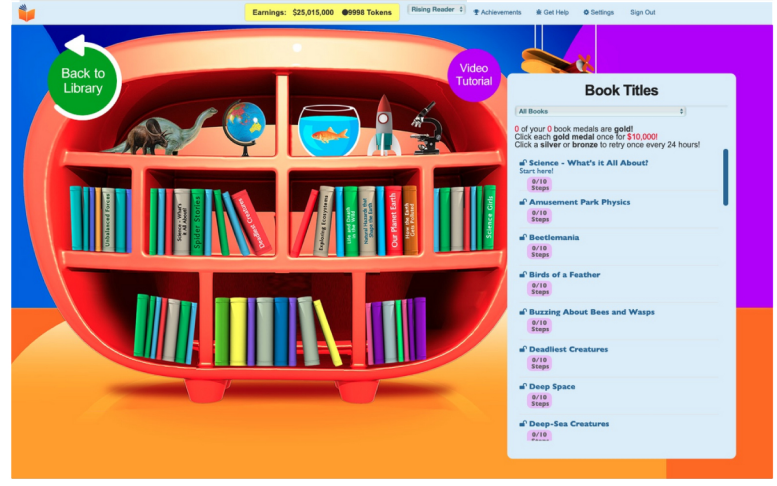
6. Rankings and Rewards

How does Readorium work?
